You are invited to submit an entry for the Weald of Kent Steam Rally which is to be held at Little Engeham Farm, Bethersden Road, Woodchurch, KENT TN26 3QY on the 4th and 5th August 2018

Details of this event are as follows, and if you intend to enter, please complete and return the attached entry form to the organiser by 30th June 2018.

The Weald of Kent Steam Rally is an opportunity for owners of engines and classic vehicles to showcase and enjoy a weekend of socialising and activities. We ask that your engine take part in the main parade each day and there will also be other events in the ring such as 'slow race', 'musical chairs', 'tug of war' etc. and we would welcome your participation in return for addition bags of coal.

Once the public have exited the show site on Saturday, there will be a road run for those wishing to enjoy a 2 mile return trip to a local public house. For those that wish to stay on site, the bar and refreshments will reopen from 19.00 hrs.

If you are bringing your engine with your own low loader please provide details in order that we can make sure there is space set aside for storage over the weekend. We understand that you may be planning your movements around other events so if you wish to bring your engine to the site earlier than the week before or leave it on site for more than a week after the event please let us know in advance.

Your engine must be insured against boiler explosion, third party and public liability risks including use on rally fields, with a minimum indemnity of £2,000,000 any one occurrence. You will be required to produce documentary evidence that such cover is in force before entering the Rally Field. If you have any queries on this matter, please contact the Rally organiser who will be able to answer any questions regarding safety policy or insurance requirements:

Entrants will be expected to have their engines in steam / other exhibits in position by 11.00 hrs on each day. Please be aware that public entry to the site will commence from 10.00 hrs so due care must be taken to make sure that your area is clean, tidy and safe. No exhibit may leave the rally field on the final day of the show before 1600 hrs without the express permission of the organisers.

We are able to offer some assistance and for every 2" of scale scale of your steam engines is an allowance of 1 x 25kg bag of Welsh steam coal will be provided on a signed for basis.

Final details and passes will be sent to exhibitors by mid July 2018 and we look forward to welcoming you to the event.

I agree to produce, on request, an Inspection certificate in accordance with the IEE Regulations for any electrical equipment (ie generators, wiring, appliances).

I agree to abide by the Code of Practice of the National Traction Engine Trust and the Society's written Statement of Safety Policy.

I agree to operate my exhibit during the Event and comply with the instructions of stewards. In the event of any dispute the Event Organisers decision is final.
